

### Standard 5 Lever Locking

Included as standard on our external single or double leaf door sets, is our 5 lever locking system. The locking function is comprised of both a keyed dead bolt, which is accompanied with surface mounted bolts at the top and bottom of the primary door leaf.<sup>1</sup>

Our range of handles come on a round rose backplate as standard, with the option to change to a rectangular plate if desired.

On a double door, the secondary door leaf has an internal pair of concealed bolts, releasable by key once the primary door leaf is open.



### Multipoint Locking

For a higher level of security, our Multipoint locking system offers internal locking cams, as well as the dead bolt, removing the requirement for the surface mounted bolts<sup>1</sup> as found on our standard 5 lever system. This allows the primary door leaf to be fully locked from either inside, or outside the property. The secondary door leaf uses internal concealed bolts, releasable by key once the primary door leaf is open.

For multiple door sets, please speak with your insurance company about having doors keyed-alike across multiple items.

### PAS24 Locking

PAS24 is required if the door is the primary point of access into the property. PAS24 is a set of tests designed to assess the security of doors against the effects and stress of an attempted break in.

The internal locking mechanism is the same as the multi-point above, however, for the door to be PAS24 compliant, there are strict limitations to the specifications for doors, which may affect your previously chosen design choices.
